THE SIX RULES

Nobody investigates a sounding alarm.

Get out, stay out, call 999. Never go back in.

Nothing that burns comes indoors.

No barbecue, no camping stove. Not in a garage, not 'just for a bit'.

When the power goes off, the fridge stays shut.

Note the time. Read the thermometer before you open it.

Fill the bath at the first sign of a water problem.

About 80 litres, free, and gone the moment the pressure is.

A tin opener that needs no electricity.

Kept with the tins. The most forgotten object in the subject.

Never remove a battery and leave the alarm up.

Take the whole unit down instead. A dead alarm is a lie.
